This funding will be used to

Improve the reading outcomes for all students:

- Increase the average Mean Scale Score (MSS) in reading by 10% Year 3 to 400 and Year 5 to 506
- Increase the number of students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands (U2B) Year 3 to 7% and Year 5 to 8%
- Increase the number of students achieving the National Minimum Standard (NMS) to 92% in Years 3 and 5
- Reduce the number of students on PM 0-4 to zero.

Our initiatives include

- Employ teacher aides to support the implementation of the School Based Reading Program.
- Employ additional Speech/Language Pathology to support early identification and intervention.
